

The Presidents' Show 2017

EXHIBITION DATES: July 1st – August 6th

LOCATION: KAA Gallery, Rt.7, Kent, CT.

RECEIVING DATES: Friday, June 23, 3-5pm and Sat. June 24th from 10am -12pm at the KAA Gallery, Route 7, 21 South Main Street (just south of the traffic light), Kent, Connecticut. ALL WORK MUST BE HAND DELIVERED. (Please bring a recent copy of your bio for visitor reference.)

REMOVAL OF WORK: Exhibited work may be removed on Thursday, Aug.10, 3-5pm, or Friday Aug. 11, 3-5pm. No early pickups. Strictly adhered to!

SHOW OPENS: Saturday July 1st, 1-5pm

AWARDS RECEPTION: Saturday, July 1st, 2-4pm

ELIGIBILITY: Representational and non-representational oils, watercolors, pastels, graphics, acrylics, small sculpture and collage. Photographs must be originals executed and altered by the photographer only. Paintings limited to 48 inches wide and 50 inches tall. Sculpture must be free standing, limited to 50 lbs., and no larger than 36 inches in any direction. In regard to prints, we accept wood blocks, linoprints, and hand-pulled prints, i.e. monotypes, etc. Wrap Around Canvas will be accepted for oils and acrylics on canvas. Wrap Around Canvas MUST have its sides covered with a continuation of the painting itself around the edges. No staples should be visible when the painting is hung. Unframed work must be exhibition ready and wired to hang. ALL WORKS MUST BE ORIGINAL, FOR SALE, and NOT PREVIOUSLY SHOWN AT THE KAA GALLERY. Portraits should show price of similar work. Sale price must include frame. Pictures must be framed and ready for hanging with screw eyes and wire. A limit of three entries per artist. The Kent Art Association, Inc. reserves the right to reject any and all works of art submitted to this show irrespective of jury decision.

ENTRY FORM: All entries must have entry forms properly filled out and attached to the back. (Attach to upper left corner of picture

frame.) PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY. DO NOT WRITE. Do Not Cut the Form.

SALES: A commission of 30% will be deducted from the purchase price of all sales.

ENTRY FEES: MEMBERS: \$25 for 1-3 pieces. NONMEMBERS: \$35 for 1 piece, \$40 for 2 or 3 pieces. Entry fees are NOT refundable. Exhibitors will be notified of jury's decision.

Notification slips must be presented to obtain works at time of pickup. A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES ON RECEIVING DAY. Only artists who are not accepted will be sent a notification slip.

RESPONSIBILITY: The greatest possible care will be taken in handling works, but not KAA, Inc. nor any of its agents shall have any responsibility whatsoever for any loss or damage to any entry from any cause whether such entry shall be on display, in storage or in transit. Artists must carry their own insurance if deemed necessary. The Gallery requests the right to photograph work for the catalogue or press information. Submitting an entry to this exhibit implies agreement on the part of the sender with the conditions set forth above.

JUDGES

PAUL GOULD

Paul Gould was born in New York City but has lived in the Hudson Valley most of his life. He currently resides in Cornwall, NY.

He began his painting career at the age of eleven, under the guidance of his father, noted artist and illustrator, John Gould. In 1957, his parents founded the Bethlehem Art Gallery, where he exhibited and taught for many years. He currently owns and operates the Hudson Valley Gallery in Cornwall-on-Hudson, NY where he conducts art classes and has a thriving art restoration business.

He is currently the chairman of the Hudson River ArtFest. Besides teaching in the Hudson Valley, he conducts Plein Air classes in New England and Europe. He is working on a travel workshop to Ireland for May 2018.

Because of his experience and expertise in painting, he is frequently sought after as a judge for art competitions. While oil painting is his preference, he has worked and taught in all the media.

He is currently a member of the Kent Art Association, where he served as its President. He is also a full artist member of the North Shore Art Association in Gloucester, MA, an associate member of the Rockport Art Association, Rockport, MA, and a member of the Oil Painters of America.

Paul Gould's paintings are included in numerous public and private collections around the world.

ANN KROMER

Ann Kromer, a Ridgefield artist paints from nature in a loose impressionistic style. When possible she paints en plein air, bringing a compelling immediacy to her work. Her landscapes and gardenscapes have won numerous national and regional awards. Recently she won Best in Show at the Richter Art Association and has been awarded a Solo Show at the Kent Art Association. Her paintings are in many corporate and private collections throughout the United States.

Ann Kromer has exhibited at the National Arts Club and Salamagundi Club in New York. Her landscapes and gardenscapes have won numerous awards and were chosen for Rockport Publishers "Best of Acrylic Paintings" and "Best of Oil Paintings". Her work has appeared in American Artist and Splash 8 and Splash 9.
