RECEIVING DATES: May 19, 3-5pm, May 20, 10 - 12pm at the KAA Gallery, Route 7, 21 South Main Street (just south of the traffic light), Kent, Connecticut. ALL WORK MUST BE HAND DELIVERED. (Please bring a recent copy of your bio for visitor reference.)

REMOVAL OF WORK: Exhibited work may be removed on Friday, June 23rd, 1-5pm. No early pickups. Strictly adhered to!

AWARDS RECEPTION: Sat. May 27th, 2-4pm

ELIGIBILITY: Representational and non-representational oils, watercolors, pastels, graphics, acrylics, small sculpture and collage. Photographs must be originals executed and altered by the photographer only. Paintings limited to 48 inches wide and 50 inches tall. Sculpture must be free standing, limited to 50 lbs., and no larger than 36 inches in any direction. In regard to prints, we accept wood blocks, linoprints, and hand-pulled prints, i.e. monotypes, etc. Wrap Around Canvas will be accepted for oils and acrylics on canvas. Wrap Around Canvas MUST have its sides covered with a continuation of the painting itself around the edges. No staples should be visible when the painting is hung. Unframed work must be exhibition ready and wired to hang. ALL WORKS MUST BE ORIGINAL, FOR SALE, and NOT PREVIOUSLY SHOWN AT THE KAA GALLERY. Portraits should show price of similar work. Sale price must include frame. Pictures must be framed and ready for hanging with screw eyes and wire. A limit of three entries per artist. The Kent Art Association, Inc. reserves the right to reject any and all works of art submitted to this show irrespective of jury decision..

ENTRY FORM: All entries must have entry forms properly filled out and attached to the

back. (Attach to upper left corner of picture frame.) PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY. DO NOT WRITE. Do Not Cut the Form.

SALES: A commission of 30% will be deducted from the purchase price of all sales.

ENTRY FEES: MEMBERS: \$25 for up to 3 pieces. NONMEMBERS: \$35 for 1 piece; \$40 for 2 or 3 pieces. Entry fees are NOT refundable. Exhibitors will be notified of jury's decision. Notification slips must be presented to obtain works at time of pickup. A SELF-ADRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES ON RECEIVING DAY.

RESPONSIBILITY: The greatest possible care will be taken in handling works, but not KAA, Inc. nor any of its agents shall have any responsibility whatsoever for any loss or damage to any entry from any cause whether such entry shall be on display, in storage or in transit. Artists must carry their own insurance if deemed necessary. The Gallery requests the right to photograph work for the catalogue or press information. Submitting an entry to this exhibit implies agreement on the part of the sender with the conditions set forth above.

Nancy Warwick is a gifted artist in many mediums including watercolor, acrylic, and oils. She devotes her creative talent to portraying impressionist paintings of endangered historical sites, and landscapes that are part of the northeastern American culture. For Nancy, art is a way of preserving our rich history. It is her goal to capture the feeling of emotion of these sites for future generations to recall.

Nancy began her career as an artist under the teaching of William Dam. She has studied under many talented artists to continue learning new techniques and styles that enrich her own style. These artists include; Barbara Goodspeed, Frank Webb, Anda Styler, and many others. Nancy was the Founder and Program Director of the Candlewood League of Artists. She is a member of the Kent Art Association, the Richter Art Association, and a former board member of SCAN.

Nancy's pieces have appeared in the Danbury News Times, Newtown Bee, and the Citizen News. Her artwork has earned numerous awards. Her work has also been the subject of a single artist show at the Barn Gallery of New Fairfield. She is currently sharing her talents by teaching classes at the New Fairfield Senior Center as well as frequent workshops throughout the area and also teaching privately.

CLAYTON BUCHANAN

Clayton's paintings have been exhibited in galleries throughout the Northeast including The Guild of Boston Artists; Hudson Valley Gallery, NY; James Cox Gallery, NY; River-Winds Gallery, NY; Flat Iron Gallery, NY. He has had one man shows at Kent Art Association, CT, Hudson Valley Gallery, NY, and Karpeles Library Manuscript Museum, NY. Memberships include: Pastel Society of America; Connecticut Pastel Society, Guild of Boston Artists, and Kent Art Association, CT.

His works are in private and corporate collections including work commemorating the 100th Anniversary of Northern Dutchess Hospital, Rhinebeck, NY. He has done portrait commissions throughout the Northeast and South and is currently conducting demonstrations, workshops, and classes.

His numerous awards include: CPS Founder's Award, Renaissance in Pastel National Juried Show, 2015; M.H. Hurlimann-Armstrong PSA Award, Pastel Society of America, 2015; multiple Kent Art Association awards, 2014; Award of Merit, Guild of Boston Artists Member Show, 2014; two Elizabeth T. Greenshield Memorial Foundation Grants.

Clayton Buchanan studied Impressionist painting with Henry Hensche, Provincetown, MA; Figure/Portrait painting with William Draper, Art Students League, NY; Painting/Graphic Arts at Memphis Academy of Art, TN. He has his studio in Newburgh, NY.
