

**Fun with Found and Repurposed Materials**  
**A one-day workshop with artist Katushka Millones**

Come experiment with a variety of mediums and surfaces. Students of all levels are welcome!

We will be using graphite, gouache, watercolors, acrylics, oils and colored pencils as well as different surfaces, which directly influence the style of the art -whether traditional or contemporary. Many different artists used mixed media such as Degas, Romare Bearden, Jasper Johns, Jim Dine and Rauschenberg--just to name a few. The combinations are endless, but the basic idea is to combine and layer materials to create unique works. Students will be encouraged to work with their choice of subjects such as still life, figure, designs and their own sketches. The point of this workshop is to inspire students to develop their own unique vision with the help of inventive techniques. Students are encouraged to bring their own images, prints, found objects, and mementos to enhance their work. Bringing in hard surfaces such as wood, stretched canvas, and cardboard is also recommended. Individual guidance will be offered to help cultivate a personal creative process. Working with personal collections can help make art-making more enjoyable, and the artwork more meaningful and genuine.
