

Scam Alert!

We would like to make you all aware of a scam email going around that makes it appear that it has come from us. Please know that it has not.

The email reads:

"Hello. Are you available for assistance? I'm out of the state now, I have absolute confidence in you to handle this. The kent art association need electronic gift cards to make donations to Veterans in Hospice and Palliative care units to buy coronavirus disease prevention items. I'm responsible for the reimbursement. Would you like further information?"

The email is then supposedly signed by a board member on behalf of the Kent Art Association.

Again, this is a scam email. Do not engage or answer these types of emails and please report suspicious emails to us. It is recommended that you delete or move these things into your spam folder.

Some telling signs that an email is a scam:

1. The email address it comes from is unfamiliar and strange.
2. The grammar and spelling are suspicious.
3. They do not use your name in the salutation.
